12 credits in Spring 2010 - full-time Pell disbursement

EQUALS 36 completed credits per year with
3 Full Pell Disbursements

*The FAFSA must be filed by April 20, processed and verified by May 20, which is prior to the tuition deadline date. You must meet the Federal Financial Aid Criteria for Pell eligibility in order to be granted a Pell grant. Award Amounts may vary for those who qualify based on Federal Title IV guidelines.

Undergraduate students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.500 to take 12 credits during the summer.
