The college does not award credits for the five CLEP general examinations (English Composition, Humanities, Mathematics, Natural Sciences, Social Sciences, and History). John Jay students may earn a maximum of 30 credits by examination, equivalent credit, external credit or any combination thereof. The table below indicates the CLEP exam area, the John Jay equivalent courses(s), the minimum score needed to pass, and the number of credits you can receive for passing each exam.
